Play it safe near our school crossings

Crossing rules for Children

1. Stand behind the yellow pedestrian line and wait for two short blasts of the whistle before crossing.
2. Cyclists and scooter riders must dismount before crossing the road.
3. One blast of the whistle by a crossing supervisor is used in an emergency to halt pedestrians

Crossing rules for motorists

1. Drivers must not stop to drop off or pick up students, on or immediately before/ after crossings.
2. When approaching a children's crossing, a driver **MUST** drive at a speed at which they can *if necessary*, stop safely.
3. Stop when the crossing supervisor displays the stop sign.
4. Remain stopped until all pedestrians, and the crossing supervisor has walked to the other kerb.
