**WHAT CAN PARENTS DO:**

Meet at one of the parks (**Bluebell Park, Lynfield Drive Park, Parish Park, or Toohey Street**) to start the Walk/Ride to school at 7.45am. Parents or older siblings are asked to walk with Tullawong State School students from the park to the school. The walk will take no longer than 20 minutes. Administration staff will be in attendance at the parks.

A representative from the school (Teacher, Deputy Principal or Principal) and a representative from the Moreton Bay Regional Council will be at the park to meet students and to walk to school. The 10, 11, 12 and 13 year age groups will get the opportunity to represent the school at the Caboolture District Cross Country on Tuesday May 20.

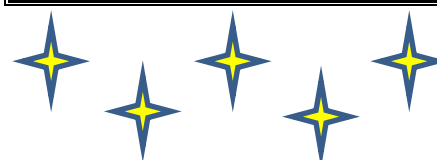
