Bee-Bots Have arrived

A swarm of Bee- Bots have just arrived so watch out! We have purchased 24 of these tiny fellows to help us with our problem solving and literacy and numeracy. We will be running lunch time games for ten invited students in each year level from 1-4.



What are Bee-Bots

Bee-Bots are an exciting programmable floor robot for Child Care, Early Years & Lower Primary. This open-ended resource allows teachers to use the Bee-Bots as a tool to enhance learning in Literacy, Science & Numeracy through a multitude of activities.

Class teachers will also be able to invite the Bee-Bots into their classrooms.

Maths Tune In Program (A Guaranteed Results Project)

We have introduced an exciting new intervention strategy where a small group of selected students are receiving some time for the pre-teaching of Maths concepts the day before it is taught by their class teachers. This successful strategy has originated in Victoria and has produced some excellent results.

The pre-exposure or **Tune In** process will enable these kids to better engage in the class lessons. Students will be identified by their class teacher and may change according to individual student needs and skills that relate to the new concept being introduced.

CONGRATULATIONS!

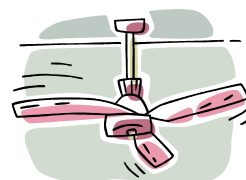
Aidan S (6/7F) has made it into the **District Soccer Team** after 3 days of School District Soccer trials. This is Aidan's first District experience!

SIGNING STUDENTS IN AND OUT

Late Arrivals

Early Departures
